


# RAMESWARAM: TRAILING THE LORD RAMA'S PATH





# DAY 1 : Madurai

Upon your arrival at the Madurai airport/Railway station, you will be greeted by our Executive & he will ensure a smooth and pleasant start to your journey, also he will introduce you to your driver, who will be your reliable companion throughout your trip. Sit back, relax, and let our team take care of all your travel arrangements, allowing you to immerse yourself in the excitement and anticipation of your upcoming tour....., Meenakshi Amman Temple dedicated to the goddess Meenakshi, an incarnation of the goddess Parvathi, and her consort, Lord Sundareswarar, an incarnation of Lord Shiva. The main deity of the temple, Meenakshi, is depicted with a golden crown, four arms, and adorned with jewellery. Visitors to the temple can explore its various halls, shrines, and courtyards, each with its own distinct features. The Thousand Pillar Hall, in particular, is a notable attraction known for its intricately carved pillars. The temple complex also houses various smaller shrines dedicated to different deities and saints,, "Navakkar Mahal" or "Navak Palace" constructed during the reign of King Thirumalai Nayak, It consists of two main sections: the Swarga Vilasam (Celestial Pavilion) and the Ranga Vilasam (Stage Pavilion). The Swarga Vilasam was used for official and ceremonial purposes, while the Ranga Vilasam was primarily a place for cultural events and performances., On arrival check in at Hotel, if time permit visit Thiruparakundram Temple It is one of the six abodes of Lord Muruga who is also known as Karthikeya or Subramanya, He is considered the God of War and Victory in Hindu mythology. Lord Muruga is depicted with six faces and is worshipped as the primary deity of the temple. The idol of Lord Muruga is placed in the sanctum, adorned with gold and precious jewels. Apart from its religious significance, it is also known for its panoramic views of the surrounding landscape. The hill on which the temple is located offers breathtaking vistas of the city of Madurai and its surroundings., rejuvenate with an overnight stay at a well-appointed hotel in Madruai



# DAY 2: Madurai – Rameshwaram (3.5 hrs drive approx.)

After enjoying a satisfying breakfast, check out from the hotel and embark on the journey to the next destination., **Vandiyur Mariamman Teppakulam**, translates to "temple pond" in Tamil, and it is dedicated to the Hindu goddess Mariamman, who is believed to be the deity of rain and fertility. The tank is known for its annual float festival, The tank is connected to the Vaigai River through underground channels, allowing water to flow in and out of the tank.**Pamban Bridge**: Also known as the Annai Indira Gandhi Road Bridge, it is an iconic railway bridge that connects Rameshwaram to mainland. It is the second-longest sea bridge in India and offers you a breathtaking views of the sea and surrounding landscapes.later visit, **Abdul Kalam Memorial** is





a tribute to the former President of India, Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, as Rameswaram is the

birthplace the memorial is built in his honor to commemorate his life and achievements. The exhibits include photographs, personal belongings, replicas of his awards and honors, and a collection of books authored by him. The memorial complex also includes a meditation hall, where visitors can spend time in quiet reflection. The hall is designed to create a serene atmosphere, encouraging visitors to contemplate the teachings and ideals of Dr. Kalam. later viait, **Ramanathaswamy Temple** is one of the 12 Jyotirlinga in India, It is known for its intricate architectural style, including magnificent corridors, pillars, and towers. The temple has two sacred tanks, the Agni Theertham and the Gandhamadhana Theertham, where pilgrims take holy baths before entering the temple., On arrival check in at Hotel, , **Overnight stay at Rameshwaram hotel.** 





## DAY 3: Rameshwaram

Get your day off to a fantastic start with a delectable breakfast provided by the hotel, guaranteeing you the necessary fuel to discover the captivating attractions that await you., **Dhanushkodi** is located at the eastern tip of Rameshwaram, also called as ghost town that was destroyed by a cyclone in 1964. It holds a special place in Hindu mythology as it is believed to be the spot where Lord Rama's bridge, known as Rama Setu or Adam's Bridge, connected India with Sri Lanka it is a must visit place once you are at

Rameshwaram., **Kothandaramaswamy Temple** is dedicated to Lord Rama, an incarnation of Lord Vishnu, and his consort Sita. According to legend, Lord Rama and his army built a bridge called the Ram Setu from Rameswaram to the island of Lanka (present-day Sri Lanka) to rescue Sita from the demon king Ravana. It is believed that Lord Rama worshiped Lord Shiva in this temple after defeating Ravana and returning to Rameswaram., **Five-Faced Hanuman Temple**-Situated near the Ramanathaswamy Temple, this unique temple is dedicated to Lord Hanuman, the monkey god. It is believed to be the place where Lord Hanuman revealed his five-faced form to Lord Rama, symbolizing his deep devotion and strength., **Gandhamadhana Parvatham** is believed to be the place where Lord Rama, where you can find a footprint believed to belong to Lord Rama himself offers panoramic views of the surrounding landscapes., **Overnight stay at Rameshwaram hotel.**
